Subject: Feedback on draft Acupuncture Profession Regulation and next steps

Paul gave a brief summary of the draft Acupuncture Regulation for HPA. Two major changes in the document were addition of student membership and addition of two restricted/advanced activities.

Council discussed the feedback received from an HPA Director and determined that a survey is necessary. The survey will be sent out to members for anonymous feedback regarding their position on adding the two restricted/advanced activities into the HPA regulation for Acupuncture. The main concern is that the addition of the restricted/advanced activities will result in rejection for admittance into the HPA.

Heather made a motion to issue a clear and concise survey to members to determine the support of membership in adding the advanced activities: Point Injection Therapy and Tui'na to the Acupuncture Regulation for Health Professions Act. Helen seconded. Yang Su objected. Motion carried.

Heather made a motion that the CAAA request a meeting with the ANDREW DOUGLAS and a member of the AAATCMD to answer his questions and address his concerns for clarification purposes. Helen seconded. Motion carried.
