Pan-Canadian components:

Pan-Canadian Written Exam will be re-scored manually, and Pan-Canadian Case-study Exam by a rescore panel of subject matter experts. Rescore of the two exams will be administered by YASI, and the re-score fee is charged by YASI, non-refundable.

CAAA Safety components:

CAAA Safety components will be reviewed by CAAA Examination Committee (EC). The EC will consider your correspondence to help with the review process. The EC will then review the examiner’s scoring sheet for any errors or comments, your Candidate Worksheet for any discrepancies, the multiple-angle video footage in its entirety, the examiner’s performance and consistency, and your performance especially pertaining to areas where you lost marks.

From this review process, the EC will attempt to sum up the errors made, so you can better prepare for a retake. If your score is adjusted to Pass, the CAAA will refund your rescore fees.

Please note that a **CRITICAL ERROR** for Modalities or Acupuncture Points will result in an **AUTOMATIC FAIL**. Please keep this in mind if you still want to proceed with a rescore.
