## STEP 1: EXAM APPLICATION

1. Contact information
2. 2 pieces of identification
3. Educational credential assessment (minimum of 3 years training in Acupuncture, Traditional Chinese Medicine or Medicine with a focus in Chinese Medicine.)
4. Selected exam components
5. Declarations
6. \$300.00 Non-refundable application fee

All documentation must be in English. If documents are in a language other than English, notarized translations must be provided.

Education is not substantially equivalent

Applicants need to complete an approved program or upgrading.

## STEP 2: ALBERTA ACUPUNCTURIST REGISTRATION EXAMINATION (AARE)

Successfully complete all 4 components.

1. Pan-Canadian Acupuncturists Examination
2. CAA Safety Examination
3. CAA Modalities Examination
4. CAA Acupuncture Points Examination

A maximum of 3 attempts for each component. The 4<sup>th</sup> attempt is granted only when extenuating circumstances occur.
