



EXAMINER OPPORTUNITIES

Are you an experienced acupuncturists who is looking to contribute to the profession and the administering of entry to the practice examinations?

The College of Acupuncturists of Alberta (CAA) is seeking skilled acupuncturists who are passionate about the profession of acupuncture to be examiners for the following Alberta Acupuncture Registration Examinations (AARE):

- CAA Modalities Exam; and
- CAA Acupuncture Points Exam

Examination Date and Time

The examinations will be held over one or two full days (depending on the number of exam candidates) during a weekend in April (tentatively April 23 and 24, 2022), typically from 8am to 6pm. Detailed information about examination date and time will be made available to all examiners upon confirmation. They could be held in Edmonton and/or Calgary (TBD).

Orientation and Training

All examiners must participate in a half day in-person training before the exam day (tentatively April 22, 2022).

Duties and Responsibilities

- Review AARE Candidate Handbook
- Review and rehearse examinations, including exam rules and scoring procedures
- Setup exam rooms
- Prepare standardized patients for exam, if needed
- Administer Exams
- Score candidates according to exam rules
- Follow infection prevention and control procedures
- Document irregularities
- Maintain confidentiality and security in relation to all aspects of the AARE

Qualification and Requirements

- A regulated member of the CAA, in good standing, for a minimum of three years
- Superior understanding and application of acupuncture and safety issues
- No ongoing professional conduct investigations or finding of misconduct (within 5 years)
- No terms, conditions or limitations on practice with the CAA
- Not currently involved with nor has there been involvement with any of the acupuncture education programs in Alberta in the last 5 years
- Must provide proof of COVID-19 vaccination
- Commitment to full participation in each administration
- A competent level of English communication
- Ability to listen and understand key points
- Ability to articulate thoughts in a clear and concise manner

Compensation and Reimbursement

All examiners will receive an honourarium for their participation in the AARE. Out-of-town examiners will be reimbursed for travel and accommodation. Detailed information will be made available to all examiners upon confirmation.
