



Dear Candidates,

Congratulations on passing the Alberta Acupuncturists Registration Examinations (AARE). We share your excitement and understand that you are eager to become registered with us. However, please note that passing the registration examinations is only one of many requirements for registration with the College of Acupuncturists of Alberta (CAA). The Acupuncturists Profession Regulation, section 3 states (emphasis added):

“An applicant for registration as a regulated member may be registered on the general register if

(a) the applicant, within the 3-year period preceding the date on which the Registrar receives the applicant’s completed application for registration,

(i) has obtained a diploma from a program in acupuncture approved by the Council,

(ii) has passed the registration examination, and

(iii) has successfully completed the jurisprudence requirement, if any,”

As such, a copy of the diploma from an approved acupuncture education program and official transcript are required documentation for your registration application. If you are a current student who have passed the AARE and submitted a registration application, your application will not be reviewed until all documentations are received.
